Course Description:

This interdisciplinary course examines how art history connects with various academic fields such as history, literature, science, philosophy, and politics. Students will explore the influence of art on ideas, values, and events throughout history, while learning to analyze and interpret visual culture as a tool for communication and cultural expression. Through discussions and projects, the course highlights the role of art in enriching broader academic studies and encourages critical thinking about its impact across disciplines. Participants will create science lessons that involve creating art in the scientific process. Teachers will be able to create lesson plans and demonstration pieces for every subject.
