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Course Description:

In Going Global: Virtual Field Trips at Your Fingertips, teachers will embark on an immersive, hands-on journey to explore the world through virtual field trips. The course will focus on using digital tools and platforms to take students to global landmarks, historical sites, and cultural hotspots, fostering an understanding of diverse cultures, ecosystems, and histories—all without leaving the classroom. This experiential learning approach will guide educators in designing engaging and interactive virtual field trip experiences for their students, helping them connect with global perspectives and develop critical thinking and cultural literacy. Topics covered will include navigating virtual tour technologies, integrating global exploration into curriculum design, and promoting cross-cultural awareness. The course will equip teachers to incorporate these innovative virtual travel experiences into their teaching practices, supporting global citizenship in a K-12 classroom setting. All grade level teachers are invited as all of the lessons can be adapted for ages K-12. Activities cover NYS learning standards crosscutting all disciplines.
