

Course Title: Digital Portfolios for Academic Achievement and Social-Emotional Growth

Course Number: EDU 5900

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Course Description

This professional development course equips educators with the tools and strategies to effectively integrate digital portfolios into their teaching practice. Participants will explore how digital portfolios can enhance academic achievement by providing students with a platform to document, reflect on, and showcase their learning progress. The course also emphasizes the role of digital portfolios in supporting social-emotional growth by fostering self-awareness, goal-setting, and resilience.

Format

This course will be offered online through Canvas, the Molloy College online course system. You will need to become familiar with Canvas.

- Log in using your Molloy email username and password.
- Click the "Courses" tab (top left-hand side of the page) and select "Accessibility Tools to Support Diverse Learners" from the drop-down menu.
- Log in prior to the course to ensure that your account has been set up properly.
