- What subjects are offered through Tutoring Services? Math, Sciences, Modern Languages, SLP and Nursing [except 100-level].
- How does one apply for a tutor? WC Online is the online scheduling software used for finding a tutor. Visit the Tutoring Services page on the Molloy University website. Staff are also available to assist you with finding tutors.
- How many subjects can students apply for during the semester? Students can receive weekly tutoring in up to 2 subjects per semester for 1 hour each. An additional hour may be requested and is based on availability.

✤ How is tutoring assigned?

Students may self-select available tutor slots as displayed on WC Online after entering their course information. This is on a first come first served basis.

✤ Is the tutoring offered individually or in a group setting?

Offerings are one-to-one or group settings. There are no guarantees of 1:1 sessions.

Where does the tutoring take place? At this time, it is mostly via *Remote*/video-conferencing. In-person sessions are arranged between the tutor and student. Walk-in tutoring is available at the Learning Commons. *Schedules will be posted*.

✤ Is there an attendance policy?

Yes. If a student is absent 2 times, tutoring will be suspended. It is in the student's best interest to call the tutor in advance with a valid reason.

Who are the tutors?

There are three categories: *Peer*: current students who received a grade of a B+ in the course they have signed up to tutor. *Graduate*: have undergraduate degrees in the discipline; and *Professional*: active, semi-retired/retired.

What other services are offered to students?

- What are the hours that tutoring is available? Monday Friday: 9:00AM 8:00 PM and Saturday & Sunday: 10AM-6:00 PM (*variable) (*based on available tutors)
