- a. Dr. Linda Silva Thompson Dean of Student Success and Assessment
  - i. Linda: What jumped out at me during the First Gen Luncheon was all the times I heard "it's hard." I wanted to ask you guys what exactly is hard, because that's the first step of reducing what actually is hard.
  - ii. Marcos: I would say the transition from high school to college is very hard. First gens usually find it harder because they have no one to relate to on that problem
  - iii. Monica: Maybe do a workshop that can allow first gen students or even first year students that gives the opportunity to 'get their feet wet' before actually starting college. They can learn how to time manage and understand what the workload of college entails. Maybe hold a "meet the teacher" where students and families can come in before the semester starts and meet their teacher and get familiar with the classroom they'll be in
  - iv. Emily: I think FASFA is difficult and I think having a FASFA workshop could really help those first gen students who don't have family members to go off on
  - v. Jasmine: A lot of parents don't speak English so they go to the Bursar office to learn how to pay thousands of dollars of student loans. Maybe even a translator for those students who have parents that don't speak English
  - vi. Rachel: Reaffirm the mid semester burnout that college students experience and something that every college student goes through
  - **Linda:** What I see is that a lot of students work a lot, mainly because they have to work a lot, whether it's to support themselves or their families.

- viii. Julie: Maybe teachers can extend due dates or be more lenient with assignments, as well as understanding what students go through on a daily basis
- ix. Emily: The teaching practices in high school are not implemented at all for a college level. I think there should be a training for different instruction and ways of teaching, in a way that isn't straight lectures
- **x. Moses:** A lot of students experience burnout in a way that allows them to take their mental health for granted. Maybe implementing strategies that students can use as ways to balance school and their mental health.
- **xi. Bella:** Is there any progress with the disconnect within students?
- xii. Linda: A little. I think by the time they get connected with me, it's too late. Most of these students I get connected with right as they're on the verge of failing out or struggling mental health wise. I wish I could get connected with those disconnected students sooner
