



TEACH Grant Initial and Subsequent Counseling

All students must complete TEACH Grant counseling each year they receive a TEACH Grant and before signing an Agreement to Serve (OR REPAY) for that year.

TEACH Grant Initial and Subsequent Counseling will explain the TEACH Grant Program and the TEACH Grant service obligation you agree to meet as a condition for receiving a TEACH Grant.

TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve Or Repay (Agreement)

You must sign an Agreement each year before receiving a TEACH Grant. The agreement is a legally binding document that defines the teaching obligations you must meet and specifies your repayment obligation if a TEACH Grant that you receive is converted to a Direct Unsubsidized Loan.

By signing the Agreement you promise to meet the teaching service requirements of the TEACH Grant Program and to repay with interest the full amount of any TEACH Grant that is converted to a Direct Unsubsidized Loan if you do not meet those requirements.

You will be required to use your U.S. Department of Education issued FSA ID to complete an electronic ATS, if you do not have an FSA ID, go to: studentaid.ed.gov, and create your FSA ID.
